**The Killing exclusive preview

Ahead of its highly anticipated return to BBC Four this autumn, **BFI Southbank** presents an exclusive preview of the first episode of series three of **The Killing** on **Friday 9 November**. Following the screening of the first episode there will be a **Q&A with Sofie Gråbøl** (aka Sarah Lund) and producer **Piv Bernth**. This event will give audiences an opportunity to see a small screen phenomenon on the big screen, and gain first hand insight into working on this internationally award-winning series.

As the third series begins, Detective Chief Inspector Sarah Lund faces the prospect of a new job, a new house, and her 25th year in the police force. Her relative peace is shattered when a seemingly random murder leads her to investigate shipping and oil giant Zeeland, owned by billionaire Robert Zeuthen. Meanwhile Lund is reunited with an old flame, Mathias Borch, from the National Intelligence Service, who fears that the killing in the docks may be the part of a bigger political assassination plot. Soon enough, Sarah Lund and her investigation are caught between the interlocking worlds of finance and politics, as the hunt for the murderer leads to the uncovering of a dark secret.
