

## CULTURAL TEST-SECTION A

## A1 – SETTING

#### **UK/EEA**

- · Real or fictionalised
- 4 points available

#### **Undetermined location**

- Sci-Fi, Fantasy, Generic
- Capped at 3 points

Calculated on a percentage basis



#### CULTURAL TEST-SECTIONA

## A2 – CHARACTERS

#### **UK/EEA**

- Citizen or resident
- 4 points available

#### **Undetermined Location**

- All 4 points available
- If undetermined setting is established, resident characters follows

Calculated on percentage basis

Up to 3 Lead Characters









## A3(a) – STORY

UK/EEA only

4 points available

Story or subject matter

If setting and characters are established, story follows

# A3(b) – UNDERLYING MATERIAL

Created by UK/EEA citizen/resident

4 points available

Underlying material can be

- Design document
- Prototype
- Script
- Concept
- Book, film, comic book etc.

#### Chain of Title

- Employment contract
- Designer's agreement
- Underlying material declaration



## A4 - LANGUAGE

English (British, American etc.) or UK indigenous language

4 points available

Calculated on percentage basis

Dialogue does not have to be spoken

Tutorials, menus

Multiple language options

Require script, localisation document, sample

## B – BRITISH CREATIVITY

Unique, innovative or envelope-pushing content

Creative or technical


First British example

Creativity within genre

Consult guidance notes

Up to 2 points available

Total of 4 for section



#### CULTURAL TEST - SECTION B

## B – BRITISH HERITAGE

Explores significant British event, person, movement

Features British heritage landmarks

British video game heritage

Must be **direct** connection

• Monty Python doesn't count

Up to 2 points available

Total of 4 for section



### CULTURAL TEST - SECTION B

## B – DIVERSITY

BAME, LGBTQ, gender, social exclusion, disability, socio-economic status, religion

- Characters on screen
- Themes explored
- Development Team

Non-stereotypical portrayals

Senior positions

Up to 2 points available

Total of 4 for section



### CULTURAL TEST - SECTION C

## C-CULTURAL HUBS

Section C1 – 2 points

- Conceptual Development
- Programming
- Design
- Storyboarding

Section C2 – 1 point

- Audio Production
- Music Recording
- Voice Recording

Points awarded if **over 50% of** expenditure on **any one** activity (per section) is within the UK

Requires accountant's report at final certification

Only relevant expenditure should be verified

# D-CULTURAL PRACTITIONERS

D1 – Project Leader

D2 – Scriptwriter

D3 – Composer

D4 – Artist

D5 – Programmer

D6 – Designer

D7 – Key Staff

• Any one of seven heads of department

D8 – Development Team

• Over 50%

Multiple points available for same individual

Requires accountant's report at final certification

4-6 week turnaround time

**Interim** Certificate for in-development games

Final Certificate for completed games

Use guidance notes for assistance

Fill out **only** the relevant sections (16 points required)



Attach all supporting documentation.

- Budget/Final Cost Report
- Schedule
- Copy of Game/Game Design Document/ Script/Visuals
- Chain of Title/Underlying Material Declaration
- Accountant's Report

Statutory Declaration and hardcopy application form.
